Not: To talk about actions or events that were going on a certain time in the past.

* Keywords in past continuous:
Yesterday / Last / Ago \at this time yesterday

× Rule:

AFFIRMATIVE

- Singular pronouns
- I,he, she, it + was + verb(ing).....
- × Ex:
- He was playing football yesterday.
- She was going to hospital.

- **×** Plural pronouns
- They, we, you+ were + V(i n g)
- × Ex:
- They were playing football yesterday.
- We were going to hospital.
- **×** You were eating food.

NEGATIVE

Singular pronouns

I,he,she,it +was not + v.(ing)

× Ex:

He wasn't playing football yesterday.She wasn't going to hospital.

× Plural pronouns

- They, we, you + were not + V(ing).
- × Ex;
- They were not playing football yesterday.
- You weren't going to hospital.

QUESTION?

Singular pronouns

Was+ he,she,it +V(ing)+?

Ex:

Was he playing football yesterday?

Was she going to hospital?

Plural pronouns

Were + they, we, you + V(ing)+?

Ex:

-Were they playing football yesterday?

_Were you going to hospital?
