✖ Not: To talk about actions or events that were going on a certain time in the past.

✖ **Keywords in past continuous:**

Yesterday / **Last** / **Ago** \at this time yesterday

✖ **Rule:**



AFFIRMATIVE

× Singular pronouns

× I ,he, she, it + **was** + **verb(ing)**.....

× Ex:

- **He was playing football yesterday.**

- She was going to hospital.

× Plural pronouns

× They, we, you+ **were** + **V(i n g)**

× Ex:

× **They were playing football yesterday.**

× **We were going to hospital.**

× **You were eating food.**

NEGATIVE

× Singular pronouns

I, he, she, it + **was not** + **v.(ing)**

× Ex:

_He wasn't playing football yesterday.

_She wasn't going to hospital.

× Plural pronouns

× They, we, you + **were not** + **V(ing)**.

× Ex;

× **They were not playing football yesterday.**

- You weren't going to hospital.

QUESTION ?

× Singular pronouns

Was+ he, she, it + V(ing)+?

Ex:

Was he playing football yesterday ?

Was she going to hospital ?

× Plural pronouns

Were + they, we, you+ V(ing)+?

Ex:

-Were they playing football yesterday ?

- Were you going to hospital ?

- Were we eating dinner?
